We wish to mark a reopening of Trøndelag's work with VET mobility after COVID-19 and hereby invite our partners in Europe to a seminar with us here in Trøndelag.

Background:

Trøndelag is a new merged county in Central Norway since 2018. Working with education and competence in an international perspective has been a political priority goal in the county for several years. We have about 4,500 apprentices in Trøndelag within a wide range of apprenticeships. Trøndelag started with vocational mobility as early as 1998. Since then, several thousand apprentices, young skilled workers and instructors have practiced their profession in Europe through Erasmus + (Leonardo da Vinci) mobility. Trøndelag has been VET-Mobility certified since 2009 and continue it by accreditation + 5 land ekstra med partner info + Norge for Erasmus 2021-27. Due to Covid-19, all Erasmus + mobility from Trøndelag has stopped and been put on hold.

About the seminar:

In 2020, Trøndelag county received VET Accreditation for Erasmus +2021-2027 and now coordinates the consortium in the region for VET Mobility. We manage a significant amount of Erasmus + mobility funds. Members of the consortium can look back with pride and gratitude on the good cooperation with our partners in Europe before Covid-19.

We wish now to invite more members of the consortium to meet our good European partners. This seminar will be an arena for both our experienced and new members in the consortium for networking, experience sharing and dialogue about future cooperation with partners in Europe. All partners from Europe are welcome to present their company. Here, everyone will receive information about opportunities for vocational mobility through internships, preparing visits, courses and job shadowing in Europe.

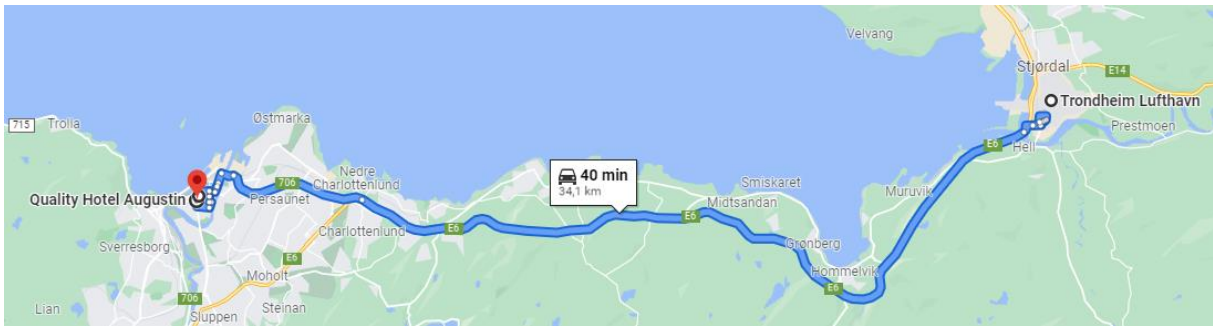

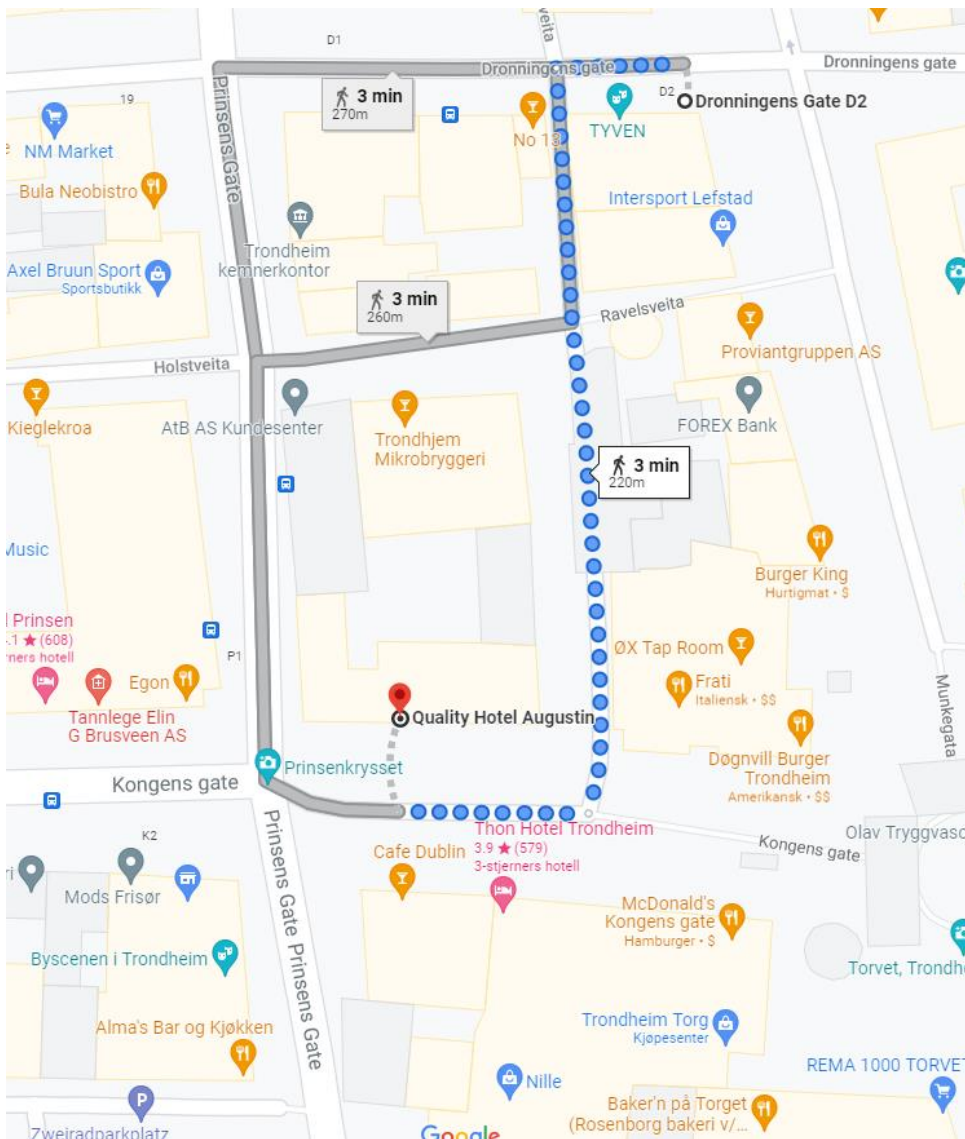
